Our Home/Suriname

Shortly after campmeeting, Dr.'s Jackson were off to Suriname, South America while *Our Home Health Retreat* was privileged to host health guests. Sharing God's healing principles is always a taxing yet refreshing pleasure to our staff.

The Jacksons' visit to Suriname, was initiated by the local conference to speak to physicians, nurses and other health givers. As the conference officials heard the practicality of the message, the Jacksons were given the privilege of visiting remote islands, where washing was done in the river and the source of transportation was dugout canoes to conduct mini-campmeetings. On one such island, the Jacksons and team held a youth camp meeting which was attended by a large number of young people from Suriname and neighboring countries! This army of young people was eager and ready to deploy to the harvest field. It was also refreshing to be able to visit this tropical region and share how local herbage can improve physical health, and more importantly

how one can experience wholeness—spiritual health. This rural experience in many ways provided more than anticipated to both parties. Place this country and the few workers in the field on your prayer list.
